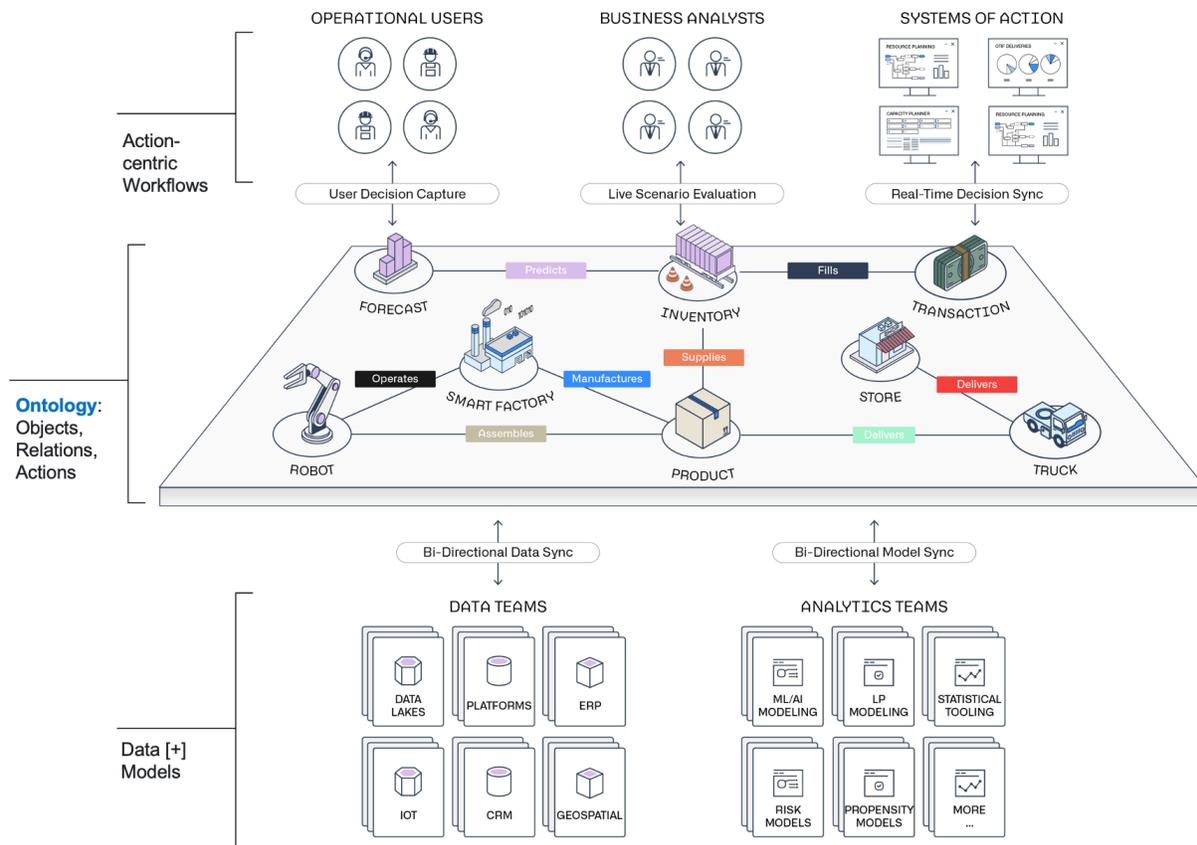


The Enterprise-wide Data-Driven Operations Platform (EDDOP) – Decision Suite

Traditional data and analytics platforms have unleashed business intelligence to the masses. These platforms often operate as a one-way assembly line: data flows from data producers (data engineers/scientists) to data consumers (leaders/operators/business analysts). These data assembly lines can generate helpful read-only insights that summarize, rather than operationalize, a complex reality. This approach leaves a lot on the table—decisions are made in a vacuum, lacking feedback loops between data, analytics, and operational workflows, stunting organizational learning.

This calls for an *operations platform* that empowers organizations to integrate data and models more tightly with operations to optimize decisions with a full-fidelity feedback loop. The EDDOP, powered by Palantir Foundry, integrates with existing data and modeling assets to optimize data-driven operations. The key element to connecting operations is the **Ontology**.

The EDDOP Ontology is a semantic operating layer for the organization, distilling integrated data and models to recognizable, real-world business entities—*objects and actions*. Business users wield the Ontology as a *digital twin* in a no-code environment to rapidly configure workflows, applications, models, and decision orchestration. The Ontology compounds and evolves over time as objects and actions can be reused in multiple applications, gaining knowledge and improving time-to-value as more use cases are deployed. Operational decisions from user-facing applications and model scenario outcomes are written back to the Ontology, a feedback loop for continuous improvement that enables a *learning system*. The assembly line approach to data analytics drives static insights. **EDDOP drives optimized mission outcomes.**
